The address is from postcards sent by her husband-to-be. There is little doubt that she was in service.

The electoral register shows the voter's name as Frank William Lucas. The house is one of about thirty in the road with no house number. Ferndale is listed as the twentieth house after number 190 and the seventeenth after Christ Church Vicarage.

It seems as though the house has now gone, as much of the even numbered side of the road has been rebuilt and the numbers do not now go up to 190. There is a block of flats called Ferndale Court, which seems to be in about the right place to be on the site of Ferndale.

In the 1901 census Mr Lucas is said to be the headmaster of a grammar school, and the roads which are included in the same ward as Ferndale suggest this area too.

Mum thinks that it may have had army connections, but there is nothing in the censuses to support this.

Ferndale also appears in the 1891 census when a Banker's Clerk and his family is in residence. It is not in the 1881 census and Westcombe Park Road does not seem to have existed in the 1871 census. It is not in the 1911 census.

The date range given is a bit of a guess.

She attended the sisterhood at Cage Lane Evangelical Free Church and at a small chapel in Saunders Road, off Kings Highway, Plumstead, London.

The chapel has now been converted into flats.
