Samuel is shown as living at this address in the 1900/01, 1901/02 and 1902/03 lists of persons registered as Parliamentary voters, and County Council and Borough Council Electors.  
The property is described as a house. It is also registered under the name of George Reuben Habershon of 9 Park Villas, Blackheath, who was presumably the landlord.  
In the 1903/04 electoral register the property is described as a tenement and an office, but Samuel is not shown. This is curious, because his death certificate shows that he and his son, W J Abbott, are living there. Perhaps the registers were compiled after his death.
