Jessie F Randyll is in Hackney at the 1881 census. She is a widow, aged 34, working as a laundress. She is shown as being born in Scotland. In 1887 she married William Richie in Hackney. Her maiden name may have been Robertson. Perhaps the two Jessies came down from Scotland together.

The Parish Record from St Luke's Church, show that Jessie signed her name and that Robert made his mark. Robert's surname has been written as Tricher, which was transcribed by Ancestry.co.uk as Tricker. Both witnesses signed their names.

At the time of WW1, there existed the Hackney Royal Garrison Artillery 152nd Heavy Battery, which suggests a reason why the marriage took place in Hackney.
